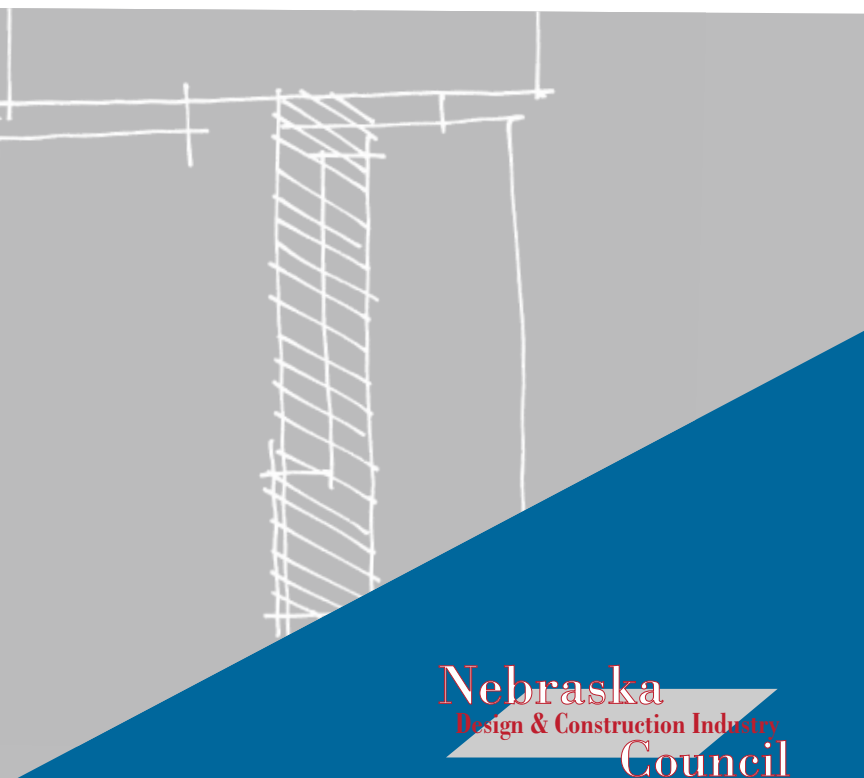

- LB162 Support - Changes provisions relating to the Department of Labor's Contractor registration Act and the Department of Revenue's Contractor Data Base for the purpose of 5% withholding requirements.
- LB552 Support - Will adopt the Nebraska Construction Prompt Pay Act.
- LB563 Oppose - Will adopt the Contractor Employee Classification Act
- LB564 Oppose - Requires licensure of contractors under the Contractor Registration Act in the Department of Labor

ACEC

- LB320 Oppose - Change highway funding provisions and motor fuel taxes
- LB323 Support - Change distribution of motor vehicle tax proceeds
- LB401 Support - Adopt the High Priority Surface Transportation Development Act and the Surface Transportation Revolving Fund Act while protecting the Highway Trust Fund
- LB583 Oppose - Change sales, property, and income tax provisions and education funding
