



AIA Nebraska annually sponsors the **Cultural Diversity/Gender Equity Scholarship**. This \$1000 scholarship is presented to a current 3<sup>rd</sup> year full time minority or female student, enrolled in the Bachelor of Science in Design Architectural Studies at the College of Architecture, University of Nebraska- Lincoln. This scholarship, in existence for 10+ years, is funded from the AIA Nebraska general fund.

Applicants are required to submit an application, including their overall GPA, statement of goals, and outside involvement/leadership and a portfolio of their work.

The Scholarship Committee is comprised of the Department Chair at the College of Architecture, University of Nebraska, and local component presidents from each Nebraska Chapter. (Omaha, Lincoln, & Western)

The Scholarship Committee reviews each application, and scores the below criteria 1 to 5 with 5 being the top score. Each score is then averaged among the criteria.

- Met the application requirements
- Overall GPA
- Statement of goals
- Portfolio
- Outside involvement/leadership

The student with the highest score is selected as the scholarship recipient. AIA Nebraska presents this scholarship at the College of Architecture, University of Nebraska-Lincoln Scholarship, and Awards Program.
